Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Find and read a story by our Authors and Illustrators of the term	Make and create a fire safety poster using what you have learnt from the fire safety talk last term and what you learn from the Great Fire of London this term
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Put on a show for your family and/or friends. Remember to speak clearly and use a big voice.	Can you learn to count to 10 or finger spell in British Sign Language?
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Use Numbots regularly to improve your scores	Create a hopscotch inside or outside. Can you count in 2s, 5s and 10s when jumping along?
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Use maps to look at what London was like when the Great Fire of London broke out compared to now.	Talk to your parents and grandparents about what their family home was like growing up. Did they have all the things you have in your house now? What was the same? What was different?
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Create a picture inspired from the Great Fire of London	What sounds can you make using natural objects? E.g. drumming with sticks, blowing into blades of grass
STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Watch the seeds you planted grow over the term. Can you make some observational drawings of your plant and label the parts?	Using construction toys you may have at home, can you make a vehicle that can travel over 1m and carry something (model person, a snack)
Living in the wider world (RE & PSHE)	We are Citizens and Role Models!	Think about how we can look after the world. With a grown up, with a friend or on your own, complete some acts of service to help our world.	Draw and write about what you did over the Easter holidays. What did you do? What did you eat? Who did you see? If you celebrated, how did you celebrate?
