Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Write 4 sentences (using different sentence types) to show how you would feel if The Iron Man appeared in Wichelstowe.	Write speech as if you were Roz when she first appeared on the deserted island.
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Have a conversation with someone about what you need to do in school (classroom instructions).	Create a game where someone has to match up animals to their French name.
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Create your own arrays using household items - write the multiplication and division you have made.	Times Table homework (weekly)
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Create a timeline of Britain Through the Ages. Can you include some artefacts or events?	Create a timeline of the Ancient Romans. Can you include some artefacts or events?
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Find waste in your house and make a sculpture.	Listen to Vivaldi - The Four Seasons, how does it make you feel? What does it remind you of?
STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Create a fact file page on Mary Anning or Holly Betts (Y3) or Thomas Edison (Y4).	Design a simple circuit - include labels!
Living in the wider world (RE & PSHE)	We are Citizens and Theologians!	Watch KS2 Religious Studies: What Is Islam? on BBC Bitesize and think - what would daily life be like for a Muslim in Britain?	In your homework books, write down different emotions and write/draw different situations that make you feel these emotions.
