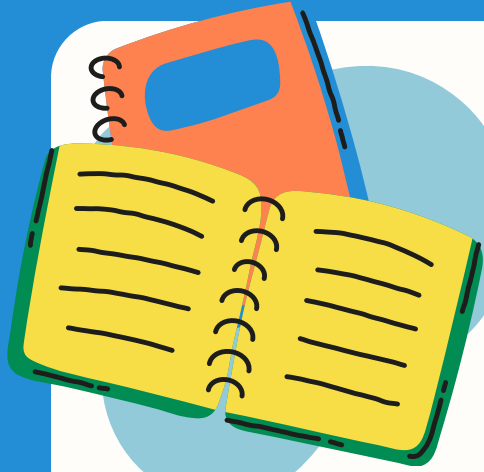

Humanities

In History, we will be learning:

- about significant figures in history.
- Who was Florence Nightingale? what did she do? what she will be remembered for?
- Who was Mary Secole?

DT

In AT, we will be learning to:

- Make a healthy sandwich.
- the process needed to create a sandwich and evaluating how well we did!

RE

In RE, we will be learning to:

- Explore Judaism.
- The similarities of faith and the celebrations such as Shabbat

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about being healthy and safe. We will be considering how we stay healthy through diet, exercise and hygiene.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning to:

- group and label and categorise objects.

Maths

Multiplication and division

We will be learning to:

- Identify and make doubles up to 20
- Identify and halve numbers up to 20
- Identify and make near halves and doubles
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Solve problems that add in equal groups

PE

We will be learning to:

- develop our ball skills, throwing and catching and aiming at different targets.

Science

We will be learning to:

- categorise animals into groups
- Identify the adaptations animals make and food they eat.
- Discover and label parts of the human body.

Literacy

We will be learning to:

- Use basic punctuation when writing sentences.
- Verbally construct and rehearse sentences.
- Identify and include different word classes in their sentences (e.g. nouns, adjectives, adverbs, and verbs).
- Plan and write announcements and cards.
- Edit a written piece.

Rave about Reading!



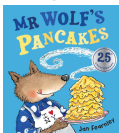

How you can help at home

Share books that your children bring home from school. Read any books you have at home. Read recipes, magazines, print in the environment. Let your children see you reading!

Phonics



We will consolidate the phase 5 phonemes we have learned. We will recap the phoneme and the different alternatives it can be written with. We also need to read and spell all the tricky words we have learned so far.

Please send your child to school with their PE kit on. Please remember our PE uniform is a white polo shirt, black shorts or trousers and plain trainers or daps.

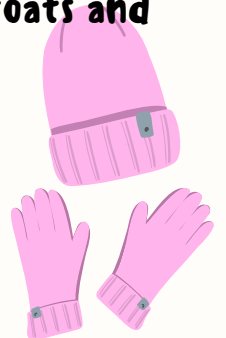
They will be in this all day, so please ensure it is weather appropriate.

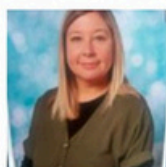
